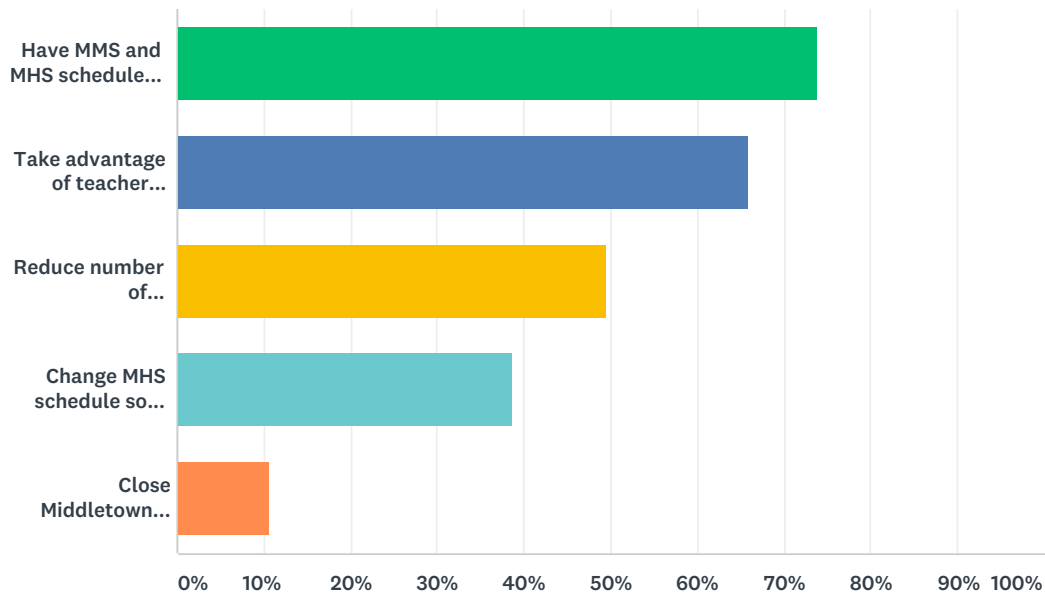


## Q2 Which of the following ideas for Budget Reduction do you prefer? Pick up to 3.

ANSWER CHOICES	RESPONSES
Have MMS and MHS schedules be the same so that staff could be shared (possible savings \$100,000)	73.83% 158
Take advantage of teacher retirements - don't rehire all positions - and slightly increase class sizes. (possible savings \$270,000-\$360,000)	65.89% 141
Reduce number of instructional assistants (teachers' aides). Keep aides in combination classes, kindergarten classes, and special ed aides (required). Give sites some discretion on how they are used. (possible savings \$150,000)	49.53% 106
Change MHS schedule so that teachers only have one preparation period every 2 days (Their class load is spread out over 2 days, but many teach several different classes that require preparation)	38.79% 83
Close Middletown Middle School and have K-7s and 8-12 (this option doesn't save the district much money)	10.75% 23
